Losing Visibility

The lack of visibility on the status of goods creates a very real challenge where multiple handoffs are involved, especially where cargo crosses service provider boundaries. Given that a single shipment may require all manners of travel modes and multiple handoffs, the pressure on transportation and logistics service providers to provide visibility and accurate reporting on any cargo type is profound.

Fragmented Cargo
